Company Description

Lab Sevilla functions as a space for events and exhibitions and provides a set of workshops that work as a common area for the exchange of ideas. The company facilitates meetings between social innovators by hosting a continuous programme of events related to creativity, culture, sustainability and new technologies.

Artistic Work Placement Description:

The participant will carry out a 3-month artistic work placement during which they will have the opportunity to be part of a design studio and engage with a wide field of design projects and design programmes alongside the founder and director of the company, Alejandro Rojas.

The participant will be able to assist in all these fields and experience how this influential and innovative company works. They will also be responsible for the creation of the graphic 'identity' of events held by Lab through the design of promotional material for events, preparation of visual information and activities available to the public, provide assistance and creative input to projects of imagery building including both graphic design and illustration work.

The participant will also be expected to contribute a piece of artwork (in a medium of their choosing) to an exhibition that all Capacity Ireland participants will take part in - further details below.

Art Exhibition

Capacity Ireland and ArtsLink is working with LAB Sevilla and Third Sector International (3Si) in organising an art exhibition based around a collaboration between Capacity Ireland participants and local artists and this will be a key part of this Erasmus+ work placement and artistic residency.

- Knowledge of Illustration is also preferable Knowledge of photo editing
- Creativity and commitment required to create artwork for the exhibition
- Team working and collaborative skills to contribute to organising the exhibition in conjunction with the other participating artists
- Spanish language skills useful but not essential
